NMYB Calendar 2018-2019

Tuition: All students and parents must fill out and sign a registration form/payment agreement on the reverse side of this paper. All students sign up for dance on a yearly basis (September - June), and understand the financial obligations. You have the month of September to withdraw from dance classes and receive a refund, less the costume fee and fees for the classes already taken. The dancer, their parent or guardian are responsible for paying any collection or legal fees related to the uncollected tuition fees. Checks returned for insufficient funds are subject to a \$45 additional fee. Late Fee, Transfer Fee, Processing Fees of \$40 per month will be assessed to all indicated accounts.

Recital Performance Fee: The recital performance fee is to be paid by each dancer based on the number of classes in which they are enrolled. This fee is to be paid at the time of registration and is non-refundable. All costumes used in performances and recital are the property of NMYB, unless expressly stated otherwise. Costumes are rented to our students and must be returned to NMYB in good condition following performance(s) and/or recital. There will be a \$250 costume replacement charge to anyone who damages or removes a costume from NMYB's wardrobe.

Class Placement and Leveling: Dancers will be placed in class leveled by the NMYB faculty. New students will be asked to take a placement or evaluation class prior to class assignment. Returning students will be leveled by NMYB faculty for the next dance year during the month of May. You may request a private evaluation. The month of September will be used to evaluate and place new students accordingly.

Class Changes: The faculty reserves the right to place or move students according to technical ability throughout the year.

Free Trial Class: A free trial class may be granted at the discretion of the instructor.

Inclement Weather Policy: In the event of inclement weather, the Norwalk Metropolitan Youth Ballet will follow the decision of the Norwalk Public Schools. Should Norwalk Public Schools close or have an early dismissal, NMYB will cancel classes for that evening. NMYB will also consider the dancers and faculty who must travel from other towns when making the decision to close in the face of hazardous weather. Liability: NMYB, its faculty, instructors and staff hereinafter referred to as NMYB, is not responsible for personal injury or lost property before, during or after class. Students and parents/guardians release claims of liability and hold NMYB harmless while studying dance or performing at NMYB or at any of its venues. NMYB considers this registration form as full disclosure and information to its students and parents/guardians that we are not responsible for students once they leave class/instruction, even if the student remains at our facility. Parents and/or guardians assume complete responsibility and liability for students' transportation to and from class and the manner in which that occurs. There is always a faculty member on the premises during the scheduled class time. Students may interrupt class for advice and/or questions related to health issues, accidents or pick-up and drop-off issues. NMYB is not responsible for decisions made by students and/or their parents/guardians. Signature of this registration form is considered full release of liability and acknowledgement of all of the above.

2018-2019 Calendar: Classes will begin on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 and end on Saturday, June 1, 2019. We base our calendar on the Norwalk Public School calendar, but the closures are not exact. Be sure to make a note of our scheduled holidays and closures outlined on this form as well as the Master Calendar.

Make-up Classes: It is the student's responsibility to make up classes, which are missed due to personal conflicts or illness. Classes cancelled in conjunction with school closings or inclement weather will not be made up. Classes cancelled due to faculty illness/conflicts will be rescheduled and made up. Missed classes will not be monetarily reimbursed.

Dress Code:

Girls: black leotards of your choice, pink seamed footed tights, pink ballet shoes, hair must be in a bun, no jewelry with the exception of stud earrings, and no wrapped skirts.

Boys: white or black fitted shirt, black footed tights or bicycle shorts, dance belts, and black ballet shoes.

Ensemble Étoile: By audition/invitation only.

Apprentice Ensemble: By audition/invitation only.

Performance Participation and Casting Agreement: It is the policy of NMYB that the faculty will cast all of their performances with the technical ability and developmental appropriateness of each dancer in mind. The faculty always has the dancer's best interests at heart. Parents are welcome to open a dialogue with the NMYB faculty at any time should concerns arise.
